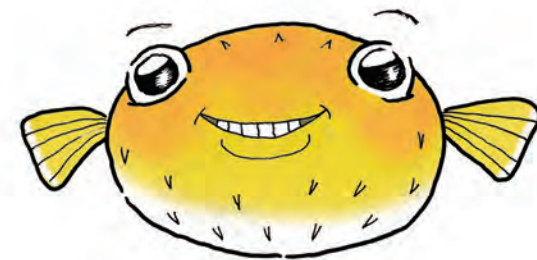


By the end of the day, Percy feels much better and swims home happily with his friends.

game, 'Bullshark'.

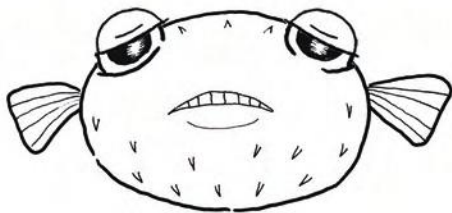


Whilst swimming fast, Harry

Percy starts to feel unwell



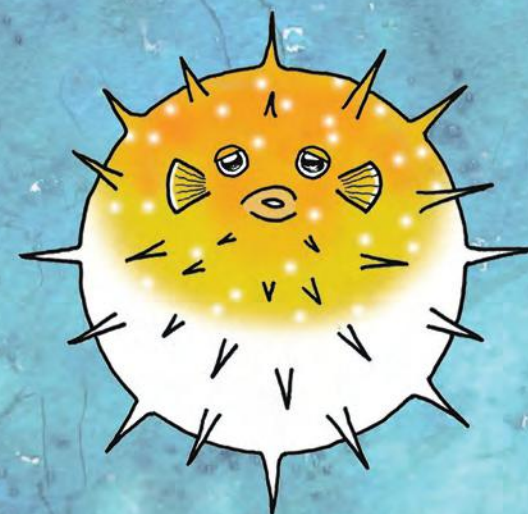
He slowly begins to swell



...and swell

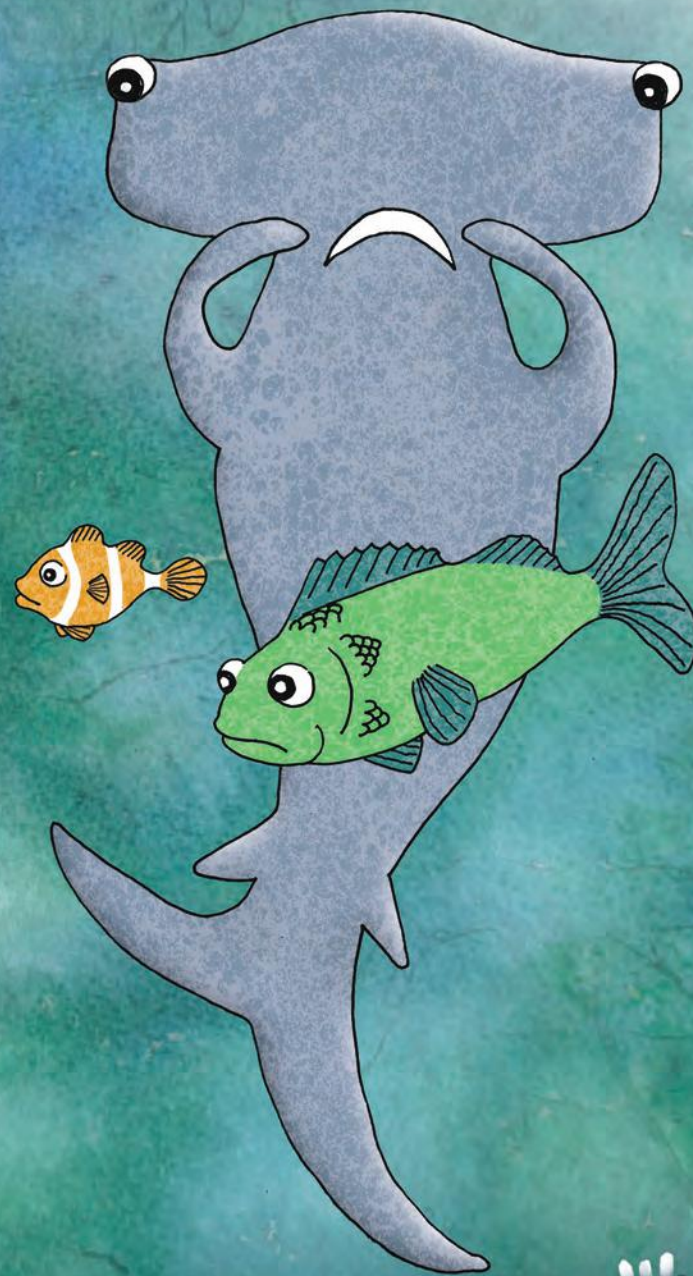
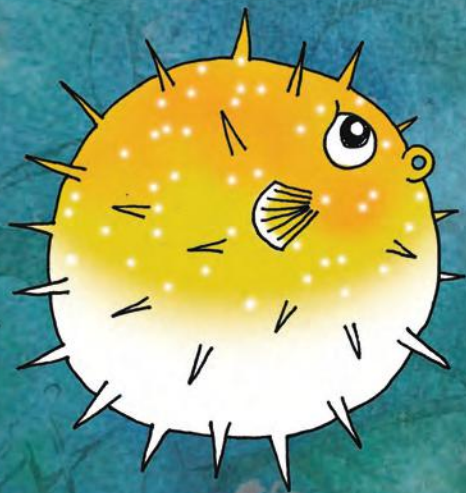


...and swell



Percy swims to his friends, to tell them he is feeling unwell. They can see he looks different.

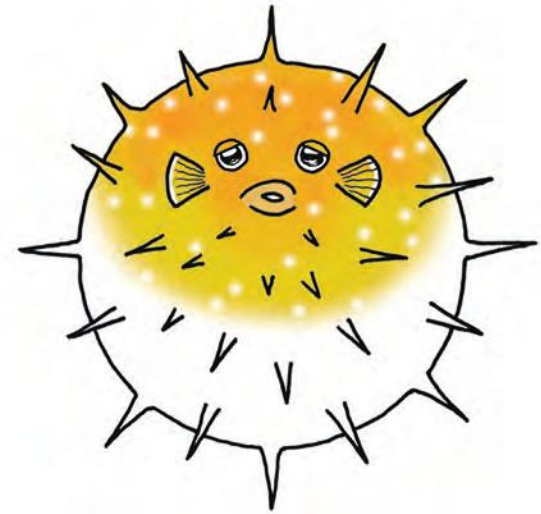
They take him to see Mr Manta Ray.
